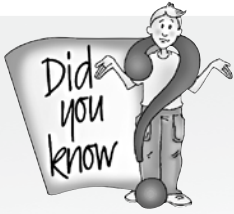

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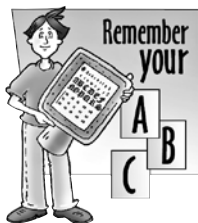

**Обратите внимание!** Если слово заканчивается на букву *e*, то она не произносится.

### Правило деления английских слов на слоги

Чтобы правильно прочитать английское слово, нужно:

1. Разделить слово на слоги.
2. Найти гласную букву, на которую падает ударение (в большинстве случаев это будет первая гласная). Если за этой гласной следует согласная + гласная, то граница слога пройдет между ними. Например: *fi/nal*. Первый слог заканчивается на гласную букву. Такой слог называется **открытым**, а слово с таким слогом относится к **первому (I) типу слога**. В открытом слоге гласная читается так, как она читается в алфавите. Следовательно, букву *i* в первом слоге следует прочитать как [aɪ] — ['faɪnəl].

Если при делении на слоги за первой (ударной) гласной следуют две согласные, то граница слога пройдет между этими согласными. Например: *doc/tor*. Первый слог заканчивается на согласную *c*. Такой слог называется **закрытым**, а слово с таким слогом относится ко **второму (II) типу слога**: doctor ['dɒktə].
