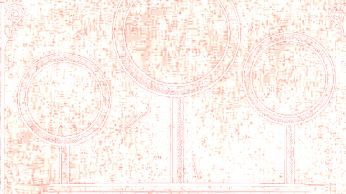


QUIDDITCH

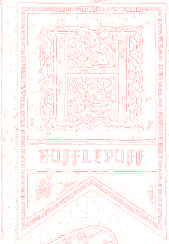
